

BEMIDJI JAYCEES COVID 19 Preparedness Plan

The Bemidji Jaycees, hereinafter referred to as Jaycees, in recognition of the current ongoing Covid 19 Corona Virus Pandemic, the Beltrami County Covid 19 Emergency Committee, the State of Minnesota "Stay Safe" plan and CDC guidance, hereby adopts the following basic guidelines and recommendations while conducting all business, meetings and other events involving their role and actions during such.

1. Observe and Educate Stop the Spread of Germs

- a. Stay at least 6 feet away from other people.
- b. Cover your cough and sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash and wash your hands.
- c. When in public, it is recommended that you wear a face mask over your mouth and nose.
- d. Do not touch your eyes, nose and mouth.
- e. Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces
- f. Stay home when you are sick, except to get medical care.
- g. Wash your hands often with soap and water or hand sanitizer for at least 20 seconds.

2. Regularly check the latest guidance documents at staysafe.mn.gov for up to date information and implement or update as needed.

- a. Implement any changes to guidelines on a daily basis.
- b. Limit inside occupant capacity to the current guidance. That includes the percentages calculated for each phase of the Stay Safe MN plan. Outside event capacity guidelines must also be followed.
- c. Strongly encourage that masks be worn by members and those attending events.
- d. Establish regular disinfection routine where needed and train members on such.
- e. Ensure access to hand washing stations/disinfectant is readily available to members.
- f. Post reminders for events to include Maintain Social Distancing, Follow StaySafe MN and Do Not Call 911 for Complaints on Social Distancing Issues.

3. Participants in events will be expected to follow such guidelines. Current updated information links and guidelines, including the StaySafe MN plan will be posted on the Jaycee website, www.bemidjijaycees.com. Public events and participants attending such are not the responsibility of the Bemidji Jaycees. The Bemidji Jaycees will not provide personal protective equipment, wash stations, disinfectant or other sanitizing products to the participants. The responsibility to follow guidelines falls solely on the participants.
